In 1998, the Good Friday Agreement made it a legal duty for the Executive to 'encourage and facilitate' the development of Irish medium education. In 2011, a judicial review found that the Department for Education needed to review how it encouraged and facilitated Irish medium education through the provision of transport to students of the only Irish medium secondary school in the north of Ireland, Coláiste Feirste.

Three years later, and there is still no dedicated bus provided to transport students from north Belfast to Coláiste Feirste.
